1. Introduction

The section should include aim of the work and give «background» of research.

2. Materials and Methods

Materials and methods should be presented in such detail that they can be reproduced. Methods that have been published should be given by reference. Only changes should be described

3. Results

Results should be clear and concise.

4. Discussion

In this section, please write:

- •how the obtained results correlate with the existing ones.
- advantages and disadvantages of the results obtained;
- the results are useful in practice and where they can be applied;
- •how can / is it planned to be developed or used further research results obtained.

5. Conclusions

In this section of the article, be sure to indicate once again the main summarizing results on your work, paying particular attention to the consistency of the conclusions of the aim and objectives of research. This means that the Conclusions should reflect the specific results obtained by the author, on the basis of which it is possible to draw a conclusion about the scientific novelty and the possibility of practical application of the research results presented.
